



As a community center, our first priority is the safety of students, families, and visitors. To that end, we continue to follow and exceed CDC and OSHA Guidelines as of July 2021 as defined by the State of Georgia. In addition, we are also following the guidelines established by White County Government and the White County School System.

- Signs are posted, requiring visitors to social distance, and wear masks.
- Temperatures can be taken at the Folk Pottery Museum entrance and theater events.
- The staff was given the option of not working with the public. However, they are required to wear masks while working with the public.
- Shields are provided for the cashiers in the Gallery Shop and Folk Pottery Museum.
- Visitor traffic flow starts at the Folk Pottery Museum. Signs in the parking lot highlight that as the entrance.
- The traffic flow continues through the museum to the Cultural Center, with options for exiting at the front door or parking lot sides of the Center.
- Tape on the floor supports traffic patterns and social distancing.
- Schedules are set for sanitizing bathrooms and counter surfaces.
- Occupancy limits are established for the buildings and individual galleries based on square footage.
- For busy periods, a system of timed admission tickets was established and printed. This system was established in the event the number of visitors exceeded capacity during a 60-minute timeframe.
- The air conditioning units are updated with new filters.
- The fans on A/C units will be switched to circulate continuously when a group of 10 or more are in the building.
- Windows in meetings rooms will be opened when possible.

We highly encourage our community to get Vaccinated for COVID-19 since the chance of infection is significantly lessened if contracted. We will keep the above guidelines in place for the duration of the pandemic.
